# Edenville ready for Tanzania

Tanzania-focused Edenville Energy (EDL) has mobilised a drill rig for use at the Rukwa Coalfield.

The AIM-quoted minnow reported that Layne Drilling International confirmed that the drill rig will arrive on the site from the week of the 14th to commence a drilling programme. The plan for the programme is to 'upgrade and expand' the current inferred resources of 39 million tonnes.

The mobilisation of the crew will take circa 7 days and will initially involve the cleaning and casing of many of the 2011 drillholes to complete geophysical logging. This should take two weeks to complete after which in-fill drilling will start. In addition there is a 15 to 18 hole program which is expected to take approximately three months.

Chairman Simon Rollason remarked that it was the 'next step in our programme of upgrading and increasing our resource base at Rukwa' adding that he was 'highly encouraged by the results of the maiden resource' with the hope being to expand on the figure 'during the planned exploration program'.

Currently trading at 0.29p the company - once known as the Gemstones of Africa - holds considerable speculative upside as it gains ground in its work in Tanzania.
